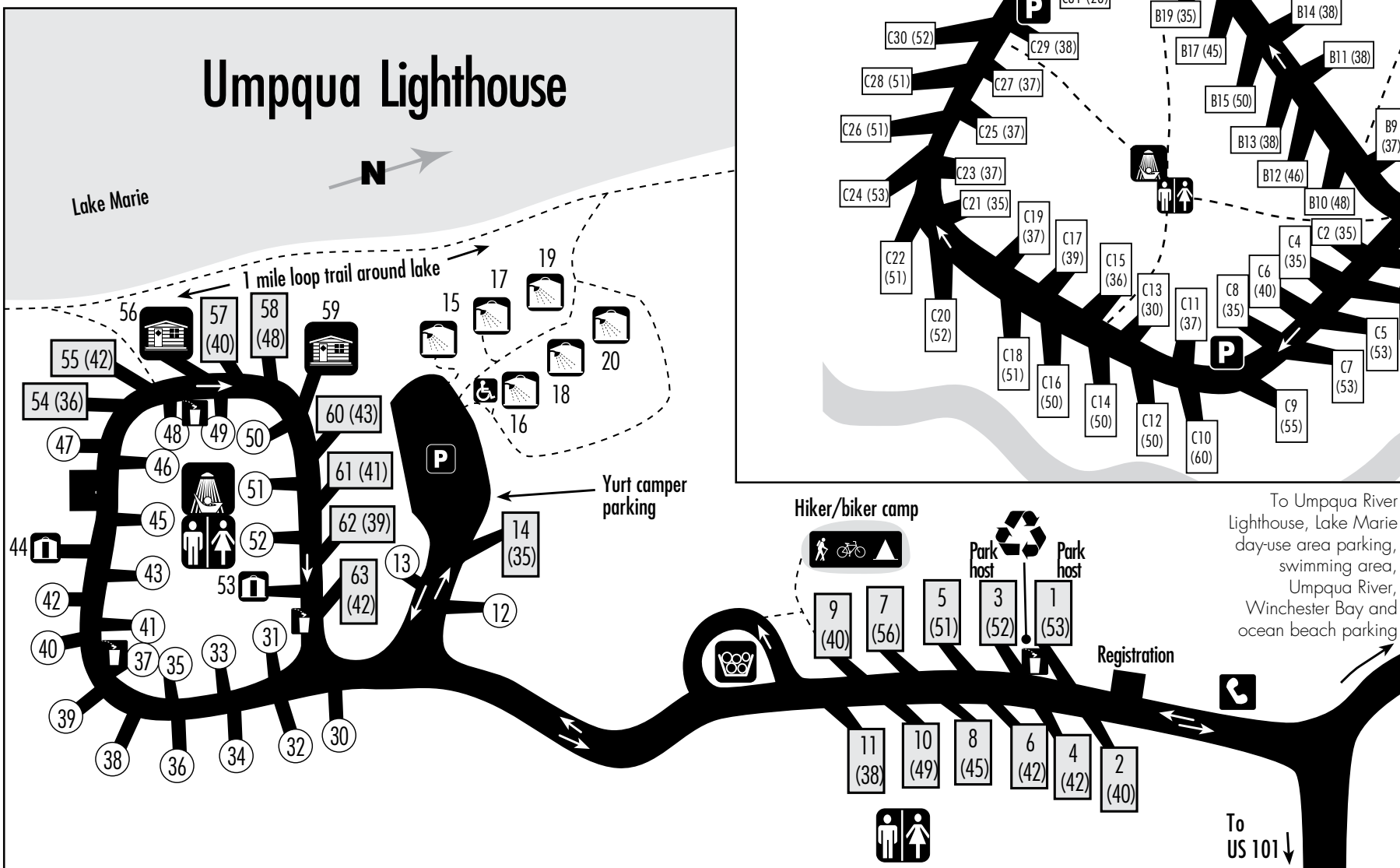

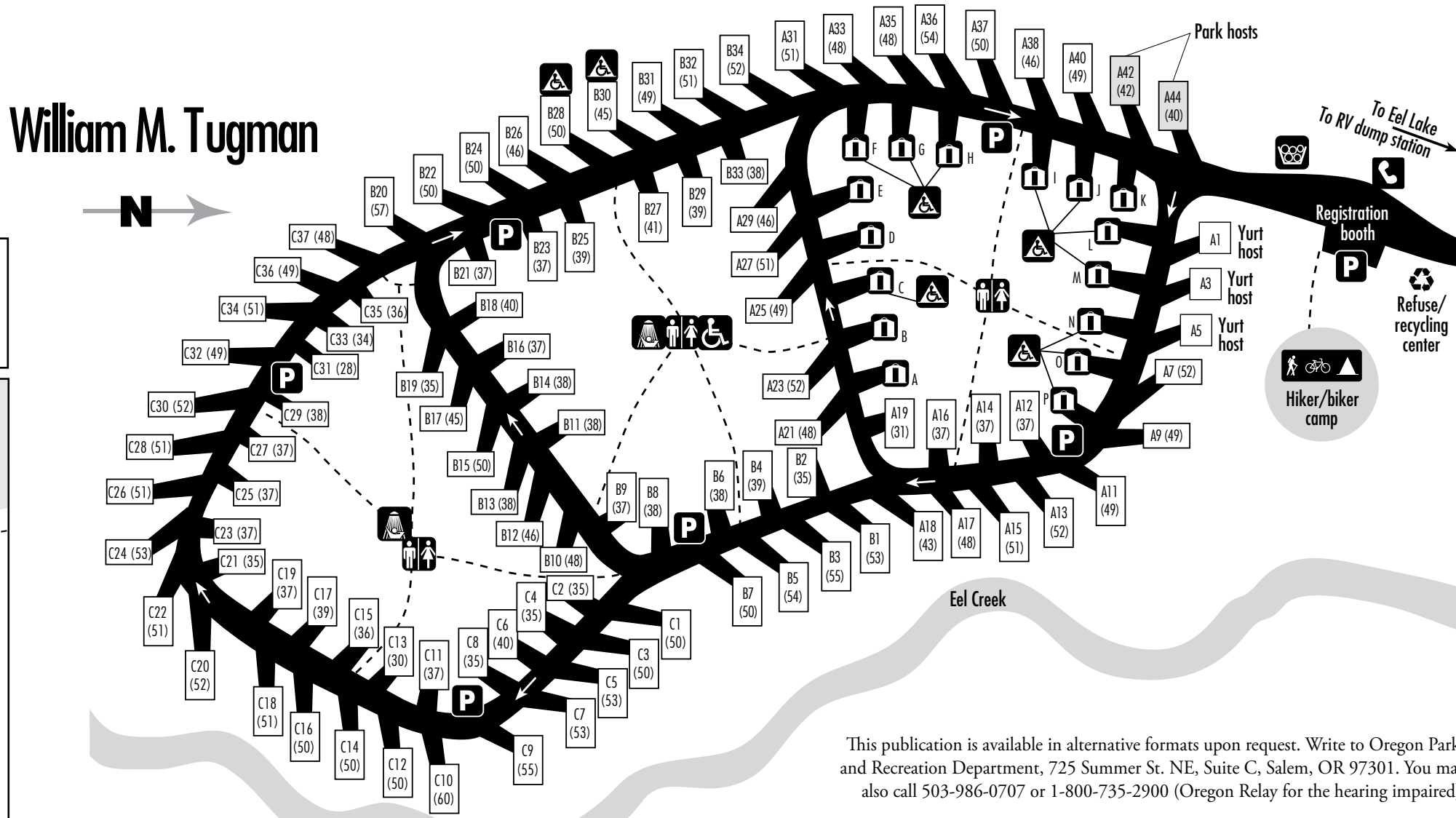

Please help make camping a safe and enjoyable experience at both parks by following these and other park rules:

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
 - Vehicles must be parked on paved areas only.
 - Bicycles are permitted on park roads, but ride them with the traffic flow. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
 - Please take all garbage and recyclable materials to the dumpsters and a recycling center near the park host sites. Do not leave garbage in restroom trash cans or in your campsite.
- An RV dump station is located at William Tugman State Park.**
- When your pet is not confined in a vehicle or tent, you must hold it, hold on to its collar or physically control it on a leash that is no longer than six feet. Wastes must be properly removed. (For details, ask for our "Pets in the Parks" brochure.) Pets are not allowed in yurts and cabins.

Check-in after 4 p.m., **Check-out** by 1 p.m.
