Meriwether Lewis Site (milepost 385.9) In 1809 at Grinder's Inn Meriwether Lewis, cocaptain of the Lewis and Clark expedition and one-time governor of Louisiana Territory, died of gunshot wounds. The monument designed as a broken shaft marks his grave. Here are a 32-site campground, pioneer cemetery, picnic tables, ranger station, exhibits, restrooms, and trails. Camping and picnicking supplies and gasoline are available seven miles west of the parkway on U.S. 412 in Hohenwald.
