Kit Fox RV Park

Welcome to Kit Fox RV Park. Our rules are very simple. The following rules and general information are designed for the safety of everyone. Please be considerate of your neighbors and our park. If we can assist you in any way, please let us know. We appreciate your cooperation.

- Check-In Time is 1:00 p.m. All camping fees must be paid in advance.
- Check-Out Time is 12:00 p.m. If you would like to stay longer, please reregister before this time. Space availability is not guaranteed without reservations. Please do not leave your campsite unattended for more than 24 hours without notifying park management and providing a contact number.
- Water & Sewer: There cannot be any draining of gray water or sewage except at RV dumpstation or onsite sewer. We have city water and sewer. No portable holding tanks are to be dumped at restrooms. There are sewers at all sites. No washing or repairing of RV's.
- California Law prohibits the dumping of holding tank chemicals containing FORMALDEHYDE into septic systems. The law also requires a 3 inch airtight threaded adapter for sewer hookup. If you are not in compliance, please contact the office so that we may
- Speed Limit: Please drive slowly and carefully within the park. The speed limit is 5 M.P.H.
- Trash & Cleanliness: Please dispose of all household trash in supplied trash receptacles. Household type trash only please. Please use recycle containers as available. Please do not litter, including cigarette butts.
- ALL GUESTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR GUESTS.

- · General Housekeeping: No storage of anything is allowed outside of, or underneath your motorhome or trailer. No hanging of laundry from trees or tying anything to trees. Please keep your space clean, orderly and free from debris. Lawn furniture and bar-b-ques are permitted.
- Quiet Hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. Please be considerate with your TV, radio and unnecessary noise. The use of generators is not permitted during quiet hours.
- Pets: We are a "pet friendly" park. Your pets are welcome with you at all times. Pets must be leashed at all times. Please pick up after your pets. Pets cannot be left unattended while tied up outside of your rig/at any time. Due to our insurance Pit Bulls, Rottweilers, & Doberman Pinschers are not allowed into the park.
- Firearms: No firearms, fireworks, BB guns, pellet guns, bow and arrows, paint ball guns or slingshots are permitted at any time.
- Personal Conduct: Please be considerate of others. Parents are responsible for their children and pets at all times. All park occupants and guests must comply with federal, state and local laws. The management and owners of Kit Fox RV Park reserve the right to revoke all privileges of entry and use of this park for misconduct or violation of any rules or laws. We reserve the right to ask anyone to leave the premises if they are not cooperative. According to section 537 of the CA penal code, "anyone who absconds, vandalizes or attempts to defraud the park by not paying their fees, may be subject to prosecution".

The management and owners of Kit Fox RV Park are not responsible for accidents, injuries or losses of any kind to persons or the occupant or guests of the park.

Pets - We love them! They must be kept on a leash and may not be left unattended on the campground; they must be picked up after. Trees - bushes - we love them too! No cutting or breaking bushes or trees. Children are to be supervised at all times.

*Excerpt- Health & Safety Code 122335 -Dog Tethering

"No person shall tether, fasten, chain, tie, or restrain a dog, or cause a dog to be tethered, fastened, chained, tied, or restrained, to a dog house, tree, fence, or any other stationary object."

The Management reserves the right to evict anyone for behavior detrimental to the park and its visitors or failing to observe park rules.
