Recreation

Golf Course - The Chamberlain Country Club, located four and one-half miles west of Chamberlain, offers a sporty nine-holes course with well maintained fairways and greens and fine clubhouse facilities. Green fees are very reasonable.

Beach - Swimming beach on Missouri River at American Creek Park. Roped-off swimming area. Free.

Nature Trail - Fifty acres of unspoiled beauty overlooking the river; hiking trails with trail markers; rest shelters and picnic shelters. One mile north of Chamberlain, at the top of the hill.

Ball Field - Chamberlain summer evenings are alive with the sounds of baseball at Greig Field and softball at Jaycee Field.

Evening Entertainment - Several local night clubs offer a fine evening's entertainment of music, spirits and fun, or enjoy a movie at our theatre.

History/Art/Culture

Old West Trading Post - Pioneer, Western and Indian displays of authentic equipment, tools and artifacts that capture the romance of the "Old West". Located in Oacoma, across the river from Chamberlain. Open April through October. Entrance fees.

World Wildlife Museum - Located in Oacoma. An educational and entertaining family adventure of wildlife and nature studies of unique award-winning exotic and trophy wildlife from around the world.

St. Joseph's Indian School - Founded in 1923, St. Joseph's is an alternative school for Sioux children. Tours of the **Our Lady of the Sioux Chapel, Museum of Indian History** (housing Indian artifacts, history, clothing and other Indian works) and the school itself are available. Call 605-234-3300 during regular business hours. Located at the north end of Chamberlain. Products through St. Joseph's Lakota Development Council.

Akta Lakota Museum - Located on the campus of St. Joseph's Indian School. Native American artifacts, traditional and contemporary arts and crafts, gift shop.

Lewis and Clark - Chamberlain is one of the first campsites in the state for the Lewis and Clark expedition.

Sights to See

South Dakota Hall of Fame - The South Dakota Hall of Fame is located at exit 263. It features interactive educational displays about the unique heritage of South Dakota through the people who have contributed to the development of the State of South Dakota.

Big Bend Dam - Part of the Missouri River Dam system, Big Bend is located 21 miles upstream from Chamberlain. The two-mile long embankment of the dam serves as a land bridge between the **Crow Creek** and **Lower Brule Sioux Indian reservations**. A **museum** and **visitors' center** are located one-fourth mile west of the spillway bridge. The central theme of the center is the Lewis and Clark expedition and early Indian habitation.

Tribal Hall - Information on tribal government and upcoming events can be found at the Tribal Hall in Fort Thompson on the Crow Creek Reservation

Native American Loop - Take a tour of Crow Creek Indian Reservation and Lower Brule Indian Reservation. Dancing by reservation only. For more information, contact Native American Loop, Kate Ratliff at 605-245-2327.







