Rules to Live By

Follow the rules, we'll all have fun!

- 1. Be considerate of fellow campers.
- 2. NO RIDING BICYCLES AFTER DARK, WITH OR WITHOUT LIGHTS
- 3. We allow a maximum of two vehicles in addition to your camping unit, one boat, and one screen room per site. The screen room may not be used as sleeping quarters.
- **4.** We allow one family and one camping unit per site. Family is defined as minor children living with parents. If an additional tent for the registered camper's immediate family is needed, it will be limited to one. Visitors must sleep in the primary camping unit. We reserve the right to limit the number of persons occupying or visiting a site.
- 5. Only registered, pre-paid visitors will be allowed to enter the resort when the Welcome Center is closed.
- **6. Campsites are assigned.** Do not set up on any site or move to another site without first registering with the Welcome Center. Do not walk or drive through any campsites other than your own whether it is occupied or not.
- 7. THE REGISTERED CAMPER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BEHAVIOR OF ALL PERSONS OCCUPYING OR VISITING THEIR SITE.

 After 11 pm, children under age 19 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when off their site.
- 8. Quiet hours are from 11 pm to 7 am. Generators may not be operated during quiet hours.
- 9. Motorized vehicles of any type must be licensed and state-registered for road use. Speed limit is 5 MPH. Three-wheeled electric motorized scooters are permitted for use by our disabled guests. Guests' golf carts are permitted if approved by management. Cruising is not allowed. Please do not blow vehicle horns.
- 10. Camping is an outdoor experience. Therefore, we do not give refunds or credits due to the discomforts of nature.
- 11. Please dispose of trash in designated areas. On-site trash collection is also provided.
- 12. No alcoholic beverages may be publicly displayed off of your site.
- 14. Skateboards, roller blades, skates, fireworks, firecrackers, firearms, sparklers or any type of explosives are not permitted at Cherrystone.
- 15. Oyster and clam shells have sharp edges. For your safety, please wear footwear while walking in the resort and bay areas.
- 16. Do not wash cars, boats or trailers in the resort. A water line is provided by bathhouse #3 dump station for rinsing boats and motors.
- 17. DO NOT dive from piers. Shallow water can be hazardous.
- 18. The boat ramp is only for the use of registered guests. Please remove your vehicle from the ramp promptly after loading or unloading.
- **19. Cleaning seafood** of any type is prohibited at your campsite. A fish-cleaning station is located between the laundry facility and Bathhouse #3.
- 20. Campfires must not be left unattended at any time.
- **21.** We allow a maximum of TWO PETS PER SITE. Guest failure to comply with our pet policies will result in the loss of camping privileges with no refund.
- **22.** Under Virginia State law, sewer hose connectors with a potable water connection are not allowed. No sink, shower, or toilet waste shall be put on the surface of the ground or disposed of in open pits. Sewer rings are required.
- 23. Campers are required to bring necessary water, electric and sewer lines with them.
- **24.** Entrance to the resort constitutes permission for the management of Cherrystone Family Camping Resort to photograph anyone while on the premises, and to use any resulting pictures for any lawful purpose without compensation to the individual.
- **25.** We reserve the right to control all vehicles driving on the resort. Joy riding is not permitted.
- **26. Only equipment approved by management** may be used for camping. Utility trailers may not be used for sleeping accommodations.
