

State Recreation Site Campground 10 primitive sites Headwaters of the Wood River

Please help make camping here a safe and enjoyable experience by following these and other park rules:

- Campground quiet hours are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.
- Vehicles must be parked on paved areas only.
- Bicycles are not permitted on sidewalks, paved trails and pathways leading to buildings.
 You can ride them on park roads with the traffic flow and on established, unpaved park trails. Do not ride bicycles cross-country. Riders under age 16 must wear helmets.
- When your pet is not confined in a vehicle or tent, you must hold it, hold on to its collar
 or physically control it on a leash that is no longer than six feet. Wastes must be properly
 removed. (For details, ask for our "Pets in the Parks" brochure.)

Check-in after 4 p.m., Check-out by 1 p.m.

ALSO, PLEASE: Use our RV dump station instead of a campsite connection when dumping a full holding tank.
