Rules & Regulations

SPEED LIMIT - 5 MPH, PEDESTRIANS HAVE RIGHT OF WAY. Violators will be asked to park their vehicle.

NO PARKING ON GRASS - ANYWHERE IN THE PARK.

NO SIDE-BY-SIDE PARKING AT SITES. Park extra

vehicles at the family center parking lot.

PETS - MUST BE ON A LEASH at all times and kept under control. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. Owners will be responsible for the behavior of pets.

SMOKING - Prohibited in all buildings and

facilities on the preserve.

QUIET TIME - 11:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.

DEBRIS - Cigarette butts, trash and garbage must be placed in proper containers.

CAMPFIRES - Are permitted only in designated

fireplaces, fire rings and BBQ pits. CLOTHESLINES - Attached at both ends to rigs only. May not be attached to trees, bushes,

standpipes or buildings.

FIREARMS - Are NOT allowed on the preserve. POOL AREA - There is no lifequard on duty. All children 12 and under must have an adult in attendance when using the pool.

WATER - Use as needed but DON'T WASTE. Washing of cars or rigs may be restricted at any

COURTESY - Please do not walk through other campers' sites.

REGISTRATION - All persons using or staying at the preserve must register at the Ranger Station before entering. All guests must register in

CHECK-OUT TIME - 12:00 noon for campsite/ rental units unless other arrangements are made. Late check-out fees are charged for rental units.

These rules are designed to maintain the integrity of the preserve as well as insure a pleasant and safe camping experience for all.

Individuals who violate rules and guidelines, or by their actions or words disturb the peace. create conflict or otherwise create a situation not in keeping with the TTN family environment, will be engaging in improper behavior.


