#### CAMPGROUND INFORMATION

#### RV SITES:

- Park vehicles only in your assigned site and only on the gravel, not on the grass.
- · Use a cap or donut ring on the end of the sewer hose.
- · Any mat placed on grass must be moved daily to a different spot.
- · Outdoor clotheslines or hanging of laundry is not permitted.
- · Do not wash any vehicles in the Campground.
- · Fireworks and open ground fires are prohibited by city ordinance.

TRASH: Bag all trash and place it in a Dumpster.

**CIGARETTES:** All Campground buildings, including Cabins and Tipis, are smoke free. Discard cigarette butts in proper containers, not on the ground.

QUIET TIME: 10:30 PM to 7:30 AM. Do not operate generators on the Campground.

INTERNET ACCESS, ATM, ICE: Available in Office.

CHECK-OUT TIME: 11:00 AM. If you wish to stay another day, please re-register before 11:00 AM.


CHILDREN: All children on the Campground must be
