
BUNKER HILLS REGIONAL PARK CAMPGROUND



CAMPGROUND RULES

- Campers are required to register at the office.
- Camp site check-in time is 3:00PM and check-out time is 2:00PM.
- Camper Cabin check-in time is 3:00PM and check-out time is 11:00AM.
- To receive a refund, cancellations must be made 7
 FULL DAYS in advance of scheduled date of
 arrival. The \$7 reservation fee is non-refundable.
- A parent or guardian must accompany persons under the age of 18.
- All vehicles are required to have an Anoka,
 Washington, or Carver County Vehicle Permit affixed to the windshield.
- All garbage must be placed in the dumpster, next to the dumpstation. It may not be left in the bathroom, fire ring, or at the end of your site.
- •Smoking in NOT ALLOWED in restroom buildings.
- There is a maximum of 6 people per site and 2 camping units (2 tents or 1 tent and 1 RV).
- Pets are allowed, but must be leashed and attended to at all times.
- Fires are allowed in the fire pits only.
- Firewood can not be brought into the campground.
 It is available to purchase for a nominal fee at the
 Visitor Center and may NOT be collected from park grounds.
- Quite hours are from 10:00PM to 8:00AM.
- Visitors must leave campground by 10:00PM.
- No parking on the grass; please use parking pad provided.
- People who require 50 AMP service must reserve a 50 AMP site. YOU WILL BE HELD LIABLE IF THERE IS DAMAGE TO THE ELECTRICAL BOX IF OVER USAGE OF ELECTRICITY OCCURS.
- Fireworks of any kind are not allowed within the park.

Please ask a Park Ranger or the Campground Host for assistance and enjoy your camping stay.

CAMPGROUND GATE - DON'T GET LOCKED OUT

The gate at the campground entrance closes automatically from 10:30PM to 5:30AM for the safety and security of all campers. Campers will need a card to slide into the reader slot in order to open the gate. To obtain a card, see staff at the Visitor Center or campground host. A \$20 deposit must be left, to check out a card. This can be in the form of a credit card number, check, or cash. We will return the deposit upon return of the card. All car users will be able to return the card and get their deposit back the next day, during Visitor Center Hours.

You will always be able to exit the campground. The exit gate automatically opens when a vehicle approaches. Both gates will be open during the day.
