

Rule of the day "Have Fun"

REGISTRATION & CHECK-OUT: All campers & visitors must register at the office. Day & overnight fees are charged for visitors. Check-in time is 2:00 p.m. & check-out is 11:00 a.m. If you would like to have a "Late Check-Out," you must request one at the office. Return all keys to office. Late check-out fees may apply.

CAMPER COURTESY: Quiet hours are from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. No walking or riding through other's campsite. Children must be supervised at all times. No generators.

PET RESTRICTIONS: All breeds are allowed. NO aggressive pets. Maximum of two per site. Pets must be on a leash at all times except in the dog park. No leaving your pet at your site while you are gone. If complaints are made concerning your pet and you do not correct the problem, you will be asked to leave. Pets are not allowed in any building, including Camper Kitchen, playgrounds, bathrooms and Rec Hall. Clean up after your pet. All state and local laws apply. Pets are \$3.00 per stay. NO EXCESSIVE BARKING! Registered Campers will be asked to remove their pet from the park if 2 or more complaints from local campers have been made regarding that pet. PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT CAMPSITE WITHOUT THE OWNER BEING PRESENT.

CAMPSITES: Occupancy limited to two vehicles per campsite & maximum of six people per site, excluding Loft Lodges which allow up to 10 people. You must clean dishes and take out your trash when you leave, when renting a cabin with a kitchen, otherwise cleaning fees may be applied. Place garbage in receptacles. Do not move fire rings. Do not remove picnic tables from other sites. If you want an extra table, ask the office for one - a \$5.00 fee will be charged. Please do not cut trees, limbs or flowers. Occupy assigned site only. Make sure your yellow car tag is displayed in your front window for security to see.

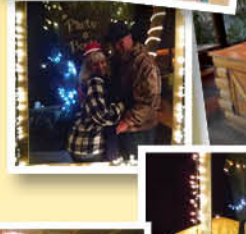
POOL/HOT TUBS: Adults age 18 or over only in hot tub. No lifeguard on duty; children under 14 must be supervised. No food or glass containers in pool or hot tub area. Pool is heated during season; Hot Tub is open year round. NO CHILDREN ALLOWED IN OR AROUND HOT TUB.

CABINS, COTTAGES, LODGES & RENTAL TRAILERS: No electrical appliances or cooking is allowed in Cabins. No nails or hooks are allowed in walls. No graffiti carved or written in or on any cabin furniture. Furniture must remain inside the cabin, not outside. You are responsible for putting your trash in the trash receptacles upon departure. Please turn off all lights, heaters, lock the door and drop off the key at the front desk. Thank You. ALL DISHES must be cleaned before you depart and ALL GARBAGE must be thrown away in their prospective bins outside that unit.

SAFETY/MOTOR VEHICLES/BICYCLES: Speed Limit is 5 M.P.H. Speed Limit will strictly be enforced throughout entire park. Excessive speeders who have been warned more than twice, will be asked to leave the park. No playing on any playground after dark. Ride bicycles on roads only. Never ride your bike through someone else's campsite. No riding on sidewalks. Watch for pedestrians. No riding after dark. Motorbikes, scooters and ATV's are strictly prohibited.

FREE TELEVISION: Enjoy 10 local channels.

WIFI: 1 Hour Free every 4 hours or 100mb. No downloading or streaming movies or you will lose your time.
