CAMPING RULES

- Camping is permitted at designated camping sites on a first come, first served basis.
- Only one family or four adults per campsite. A family unit is considered to be two adults and minor children residing in the same household.
- A camper shall not occupy the same campsite for more than 14 consecutive days.
- Payment of camping fees must be kept current. The campsite must be vacated or renewed by 3:00 p.m. on the day the permit expires.
- Quiet hours are between 10:30 pm and 6:00 am Remember a number of our campers are anglers or travelers who go to bed early.
- The park is closed from 10:30 p.m. 4:00 am. All visitors not registered at a campsite must leave prior to closing hours.
- All fires must be built in designated areas.
 Only legalized Iowa fireworks are permitted.
- All pets must be kept on a leash, have current vaccines and be promptly cleaned up after.
- Please deposit garbage in the designated containers. Recycling is expected in Jackson County. Help keep future campground fees down by obeying the recycling rules of the county.
- All registered campsites must contain a camping unit overnight.

ABOUT THE AREA

South Sabula Lake Park, located on the south edge of Sabula, Iowa, is just one of 35 areas managed by the Jackson County Conservation Board. This 14-acre park lies on the banks of the Mississippi River and the 100-acre South Sabula Lake allowing the boating and fishing enthusiast easy access to campsites.

LOCATION

South Sabula Lakes Park is physically located at the southern most end of South Avenue in Sabula. Take highway 52/64 into Sabula. Go south on Broad Street, which turns into South Avenue under the train bridge. Follow South Ave into South Sabula Lakes Park.

CAMPING INFORMATION

Campground is open April through October, weather permitting. All camping sites are provided with 30 to 50 amp electrical service, picnic table and fire pit. Enter the campground and choose a non-ticketed site. Campers must self-register within 1 hour of arrival at the campground.

BOATING

Boaters and fishers have easy water access and boats can be moored right behind most campsites. A hard surface boat ramp and a parking lot for trailers are available.


Firewood and ice are available from the campground attendant May through September.
